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The University of Makeni launched the Futures Literacy Center on Thursday 26th May, 2022. The Future Literacy Center is the base of the Women's Future's Project, an action research collaboration between UNESCO, the University of Makeni, the Ministry of Gender and Children's Affairs and Badenya Inc., funded by the International Development Research Center (IDRC).

This action research process will test the hypothesis that the systems and processes that shape why and how people imagine the future have important implications for understanding and potentially changing gender relations and empowering women. It will apply the UNESCO Futures Literacy Labs approach in which participants from various walks of life in Sierra Leone, collaborate to develop collective intelligence of alternative futures.

The alternative futures define significant challenges, opportunities, diverse, and critical phases that can influence innovation, market development, and policy choices in the future. Participants will explore their assumption that frame the future of women in Sierra Leone and the implications we have for perceptions of the role of women in society.

This project will connect local experiences to a global community of research and practice, allowing learning to be documented and shared more broadly. It will also help establish the condition for a possible UNESCO Chair at the University of Makeni.

The invited guests include the representatives of the Sierra Leone National Commission of UNESCO; the Sierra Leone Ministry of Gender and Children's Affairs; the Embassy of Canada in Sierra Leone; IDRC and friends and colleagues involved in the project.
